



Application Information

Purpose

The purpose of the Shamrock Chapter of National Residence Hall Honorary (NRHH) shall be to promote leadership and programming excellence, develop the skills and abilities of students, and recognize outstanding programming and service within the Residential Life system at Missouri S&T.

Qualifications

- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 (3.0 preferred) and cannot be on academic probation at the time of selection.
- Residence in Residential Life housing a minimum of two full semesters before the application may take place, and must reside in Residential Life housing during the semester in which they apply.
- Exhibited outstanding leadership and service within the Residential Life system.

Expectations

- Attend weekly NRHH meetings. (These are currently held Thursday at 9:00 pm but change every semester.)
- Plan, organize and attend NRHH Leadership Trip and NRHH Leadership Lock-In.
- Actively encourage local OTM submissions.
- Participate in at least one committee: Promote, Develop, or Recognize.
- Write and submit Regional OTMs by the announced due date.
- Participate in fundraisers such as concessions, refrigerator replacement and mailings.
- Communicate with NRHH alumni.
- Be a contributing member of Missouri S&T's active NRHH chapter.

Application

- Applications are due to the Residential Life Department Office, 205 West 12th Street, by 4:00 pm, Thursday, November 5th.
- Applicants will be notified by Wednesday, November 11th and are expected to attend induction at 4:00 pm, Friday, November 13th.

4. What is your biggest weakness, and how will you work to overcome your weakness in the future?
