#### What are Integrated Development Environments?

- Combines editor, project management, compiler, debugger, etc. into one program.
- Commonly used on Windows (and OS X, to a lesser extent).
- Usually feature code completion.
- Provide a build management system for complicated projects.
- ► Some come with graphical tools for building GUIs.

## Building with Geany

- ▶ ¶ Builds the project
- ▶ f5 Runs the project
- ▶ f8 Builds only the current file

Note: Build is broken for multi-file projects.

# Writing code with Geany

- Ctrl + t Go to function implementation.
- ► Ctrl + space Show completions.
- ► Edit Preferences Editor Indentation Change 'Type' to 'Spaces'.
- You can auto-close brackets and parentheses as well.

## Building with CodeBlocks

- ▶ f9 Build and run
- ► Ctrl + f9 Build
- ► Ctrl + f10 Run
- Project Build Options Enable -Wall

### Writing code with Code::Blocks

- ► Ctrl + . Go to function implementation.
- ▶ Ctrl + 1 + . Go to function declaration.
- ► Ctrl + space Show completions.
- Right-click on a file and choose 'Format this file' to autoformat.
