# Guidelines for Depth and Technical Electives in Civil Engineering, catalog years FS 09 and later

October 23, 2014

The Civil Engineering curriculum for students with a catalog year of FS 09 or later includes 3 Depth and 2 Technical Electives. Every BSCE student is required to have depth in 4 areas of Civil Engineering. CE 3201 followed by both CE 3210 and CE 3220 is required, so every student will have depth in the structural engineering area. The three depth electives must be taken in 3 of the remaining 6 areas (construction, environmental, geotechnical, materials, transportation, and water resources). The depth electives must be from three different areas. The two technical electives can be selected from any of the seven areas.

The faculties in the seven areas of CE have developed guidelines to help in selecting a set of electives that fit your interest. Choose them wisely. While all the electives are good and useful engineering courses, your career choice will determine which courses are most useful to you.

The attached matrix of courses and areas will assist in selecting and keeping track of your depth and technical electives.

## **Construction Engineering**

#### Depth Electives:

Choose one depth elective from the construction engineering area listing. Choose two additional depth electives depending on your specialty interest within construction engineering.

- Geotechnical: CE 4729 plus one course from the remaining areas (Environmental, Transportation, Materials, Water Resources)\*
- Environmental: CE 3615 plus one course from the remaining areas (Geotechnical, Transportation, Materials, Water Resources)\*
- Transportation: CE 5510 plus one course from the remaining areas (Geotechnical, Environmental, Materials, Water Resources)\*
- Materials: CE 5112 or CE 5113 plus one course from the remaining areas (Geotechnical, Transportation, Environmental, Water Resources)\*

#### Technical Electives:

Choose one technical elective from the construction engineering area.

Choose one technical elective from any area \*

## **Materials Engineering**

#### Depth Electives:

Choose one depth elective from the materials engineering area listing. Choose two additional depth electives from the following: CE 4729, CE 3615, or CE 5510.

#### Technical Electives:

Choose two technical electives from the materials area.\*

# **Environmental Engineering**

Depth Electives:

Choose CE 4729 and CE 3615 as depth electives.

Choose one additional depth elective from the water resources engineering area listing.\* Technical Electives:

Choose CE 5619 as one technical elective.

Choose from the list in the current catalog.

## **Geotechnical Engineering**

Depth Electives (3 total):

Choose CE 4729 as one depth elective

Choose two additional depth electives from the water resources engineering, materials engineering and environmental engineering areas.\*

Technical Electives:

Choose CE 5715 or CE 5729 as one technical elective.

Choose one technical elective from any area.\*

## **Water Resources Engineering**

Depth Electives:

Choose one depth elective from the water resources engineering area listing.\*

Choose two additional depth electives from the environmental, transportation, materials, construction or geotechnical engineering areas.\*

Technical Electives:

Choose two technical electives from the water resources engineering area listing.\*

## **Transportation Engineering**

Depth Electives:

Choose one depth elective from the transportation engineering area course listing.\* Choose two additional depth electives from the environmental, water resources, materials, construction or geotechnical engineering areas.\*

Technical Electives:

Choose two depth electives from the transportation engineering area course listing.\*

## **Structural Engineering**

Depth Electives:

Choose three depth electives the environmental, transportation, materials, construction, water resources or geotechnical engineering areas.

Technical Electives:

Choose two depth electives from the structural engineering are course listing.

#### Name:

Every student must have <u>depth in 4 areas</u>. Depth courses are *primarily* (not always) courses that have another CE course in the same area as a prerequisite, excluding CE 3334, as CE 3330 is considered a basic science course. Structures is a required depth area, students take 3210 & 3220. Three depth courses in other areas must be taken. In addition, there are 2 technical electives that can be taken in any area. Use this matrix in conjuction with the "Guidelines for Depth and Technical Electives in Civil Engineering" and your advisor to select your electives.

NOTE that many of these courses are NOT offered every semester
